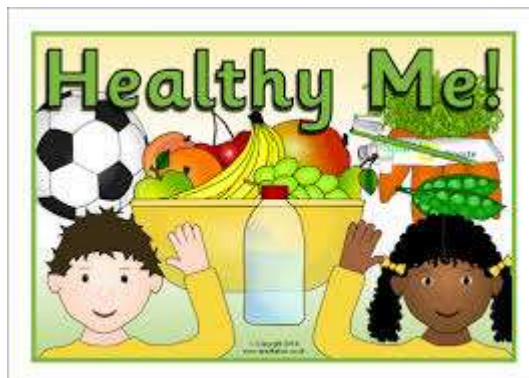


Key Stage 1, Summer Term 1, Theme Curriculum Overview

Healthy Me



As scientists we will:

- Ask simple questions.
 - Observe closely, using simple equipment.
 - Perform simple tests.
 - Identify and classify.
 - Use observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions.
 - Gather and record data to help in answering questions.

- Identify name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
 - Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
 - Investigate and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air).
 - Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and hygiene.

As writers we will:

- Present information
- Write recounts
- Produce glossaries
- Write stories
- Create and recite poetry

As artists we will:

Make sculptures:

- Use a combination of shapes.
- Include lines and texture.



- Use rolled up paper, straws, paper, card and clay as materials.
- Use techniques such as rolling, cutting, moulding and carving.

Digital media:

Use a wide range of tools to create different textures, lines, tones, colours and shapes.

As mathematicians we will:

- Look at proportions of different types of food to compare how much, and of what, we should eat/drink.
- Collect statistics such as class eye/hair colour so that we can construct pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and tables

As games players we will:

- Use the terms 'opponent' and 'team-mate'.
- Use rolling, hitting, running, jumping, catching and kicking skills in combination.
- Develop tactics.
- Lead others when appropriate.
- Learn how to lead a healthy lifestyle.

As musicians we will:

- Understand and imitate changes in pitch.
- Use symbols to represent a composition and use them to help with a performance.
- Recognise changes in timbre, dynamics and pitch.

In Design Technology we will:

- Cut, peel or grate ingredients safely and hygienically.
- Measure or weigh using measuring cups or electronic scales.
- Assemble or cook ingredients.

In Computing we will:

- Understand online risks and the age rules for sites.
- Use a range of applications e.g. excel, powerpoint, google docs, and devices e.g. tablets, radio station, in order to communicate ideas, work and messages.

In RE we will:

- We will learn to identify when it is easy and difficult to show friendship and to explore when Jesus may have found it difficult.
